## \*What is neurodiversity?



This is a term often used to describe people who think, see or respond to the world in diverse ways. This may be linked to a known neurodevelopmental condition (e.g. Autism, ADHD, Developmental Coordination Disorder, Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder), specific difficulties (e.g. Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, speech and language, sensory), their mental health or their previous experiences.
